



Report on MDA Training and ASHA Day Celebration

Dr. Rahulnetra Gawkar (Department of PSM) delivered a lecture on newborn care and geriatric care.

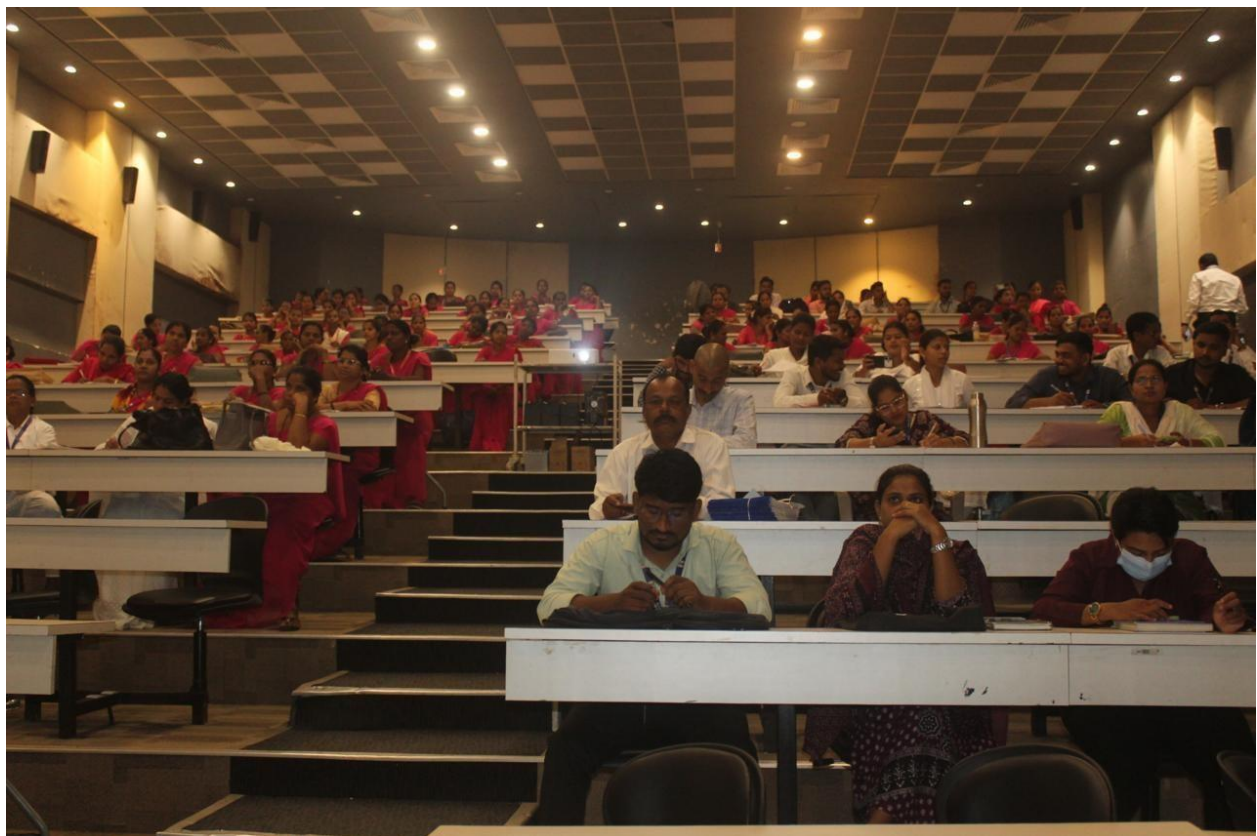
Dr. Harshada Shah delivered a lecture on Prevention and Prohibition of Sexual Harassment at the Workplace (POSH Act, 2013).
