A 28-year-old female presented to our outpatient department with a history of a prominent swelling on the front of her neck, which had been progressively enlarging over the past 18 years. Clinical evaluation revealed a massive anterior neck mass measuring approximately 30 x 20 x 10 cm, diagnosed as Multiple Nodular Goitre. Our highly skilled ENT surgical team, led by Dr. Pramod Shiralkar, HOD, ENT with the able support of Dr. Nikesh Gosrani, Asst Professor, Dr. Srushti Patil, and Dr. Owais Gigani, flawlessly performed a meticulous excision of the mass under general anaesthesia. The excised thyroid mass weighed an astonishing 1 kg, a rare and impressive surgical case. The patient is extremely satisfied with the results and her transformation from living with a long-standing goitre to enjoying a symptom-free life reflects the outstanding commitment and proficiency of our medical team.
