It is to inform that the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reviewed the Assessor's report (05th April, 2022) regarding faculty, their experience, publications other teaching facilities including infrastructure available at Vedanta Institute of Medical Sciences, Palghar under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in the state of Andhra Pradesh for Starting of course MS (Orthopaedics) for the academic year 2022-23.

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) has made the following decision:

APPROVED FOR -3 SEATS IN MS (Orthopaedics)

1. Overall clinical material is grossly inadequate

2. Only 8-9 surgeries in a week, with 18 qualified orthopaedic doctors (6 Sr. Residents & 12 faculty) is grossly inadequate to train the requested 9 PGs (amounting to 9X3 = 27 PG residents).

There are no deliveries reported in the hospital on the day of assessment.

4. The diagnostic tests done are only 75 X-rays, 10 USG, 5scan, 4 MRI and only 600 CBP, 1 Cytology, 1 HPE, 50 Micro-biology reveals that the clinical load is very less even to start Post-graduate course with 150 MBBS seats . It is not justified to grant more seats in the beginning of the course.

- 1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, building, equipment and hospital facilities as per National Medical Commission norms.
- 2. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB).
- 3. The Private Medical College should provide Bank Guarantee against establishment of new course of Seats 03 in favour of National Medical Commission, New Delhi valid for 03 years or till the course is recognised, whichever is later, from a nationalized/scheduled Bank in accordance with NMC norms. However, medical college/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- The Medical Colleges/ Institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend during the during the Post Graduate studies similar to UG sections of Govt. Medical Colleges in their State.
- The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reserve the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the Letter of Intent/Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained from Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) by misrepresentative of facts or

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College / Institution that the information relating to admission should be submitted within the time specified by this office from time to time. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be constructed that the admission in the college were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Commission to proceed with law against the college.

Action to grant formal permission of the Medical Assessment & Rating Board (MARB) for increase of Seats in the said course at your college will be initiated on receipt of appropriate bank guarantee, if applicable and undertaking/compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated above.

The acceptance letter may be sent within 1 week from the date of issue of this letter / you may otherwise opt to follow the section 28(3)(5)(6) of NMC Act 2019 to enable the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) to issue Letter of Permission for the academic year 2022-23.
